## Downloading Digital Certificate in eToken

The Digital Certificate can be downloaded directly into your eToken but before that ensure to install eToken drivers (PKI Client 4.55 version) on your PC from the (n)Code Resource CD provided to you. Alternatively eToken drivers can also be downloaded from our website:

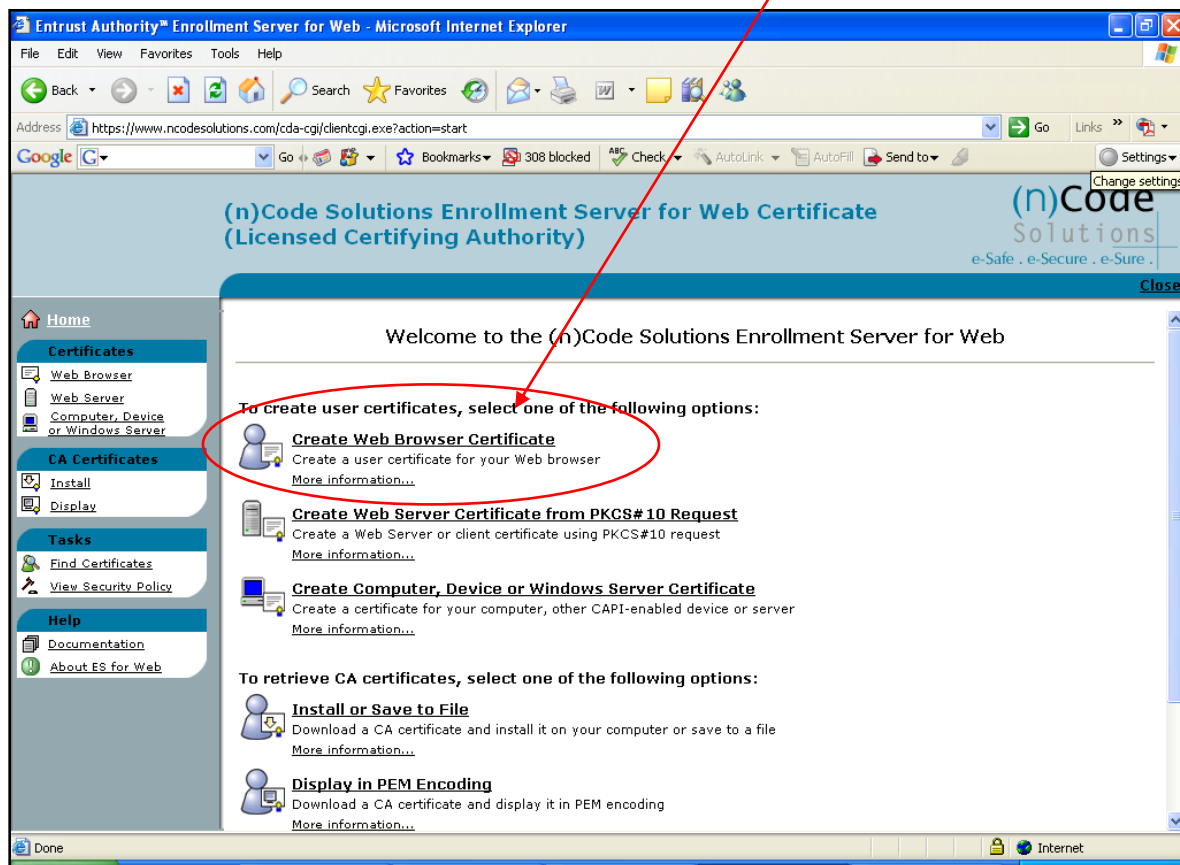

## Steps for downloading certificate


**STEP 1:** You will receive an email with Reference Number & Authorization Code on your registered email ID from (n)Code Registration Authority ([ra@ncodesolutions.com](mailto:ra@ncodesolutions.com)).

**STEP 2:** On receiving above email, click on the link:

Following page will open – Click on **“Create Web Browser Certificate”**




**STEP 3:** Enter (or copy / paste) “Reference Number” & “Authorization Code” as provided in email and ensure to select CSP Type: **RSA Full** and CSP as “**eToken Base Cryptographic Provider**”



**STEP 3:** After filling details as above click on “Submit Request” button

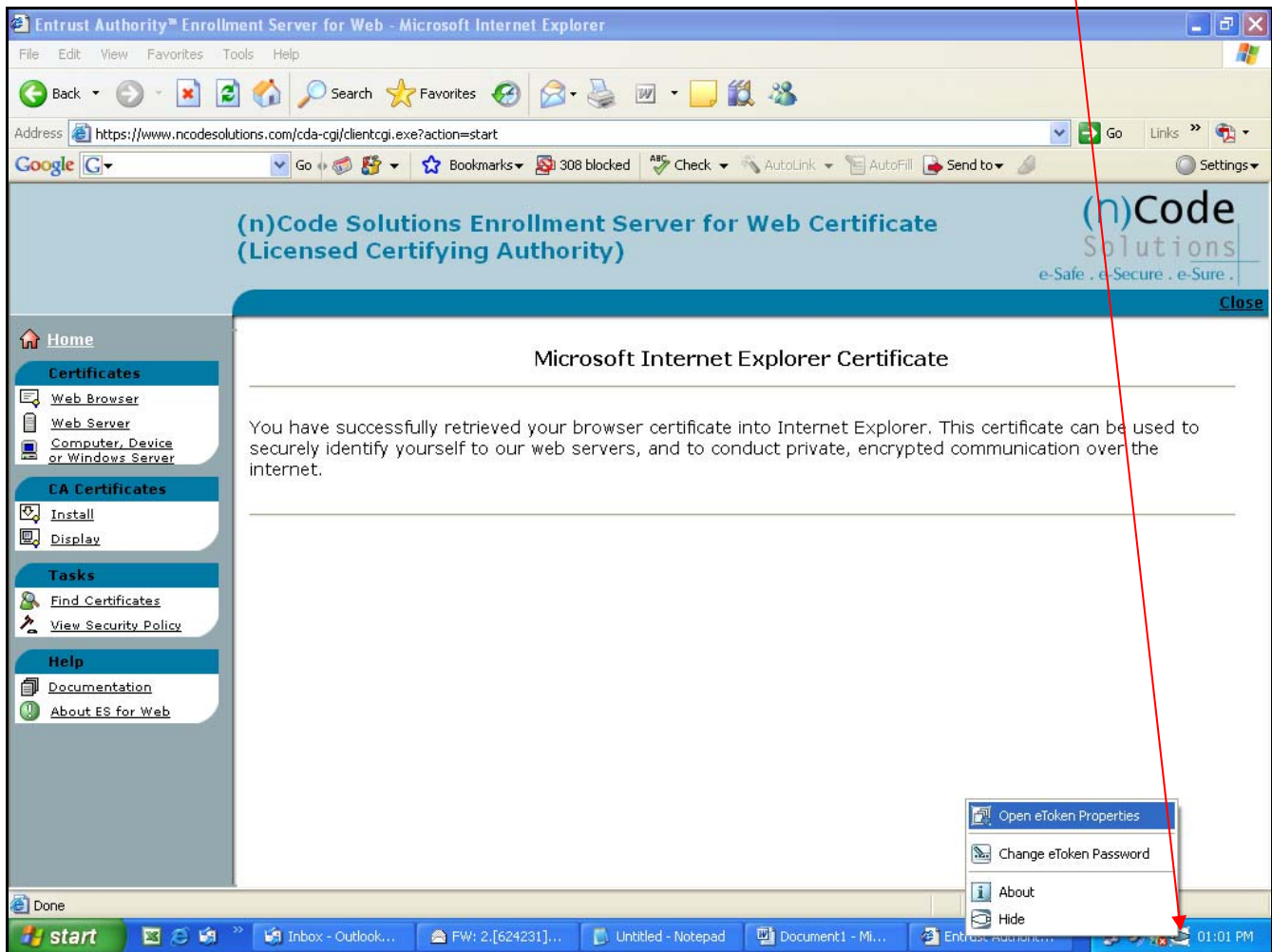
**NOTE:** After clicking “Submit Request” – click on YES and OK on every prompt you receive while downloading the certificate

**STEP 4:** You will be prompted to enter eToken Password – enter the same and click ok



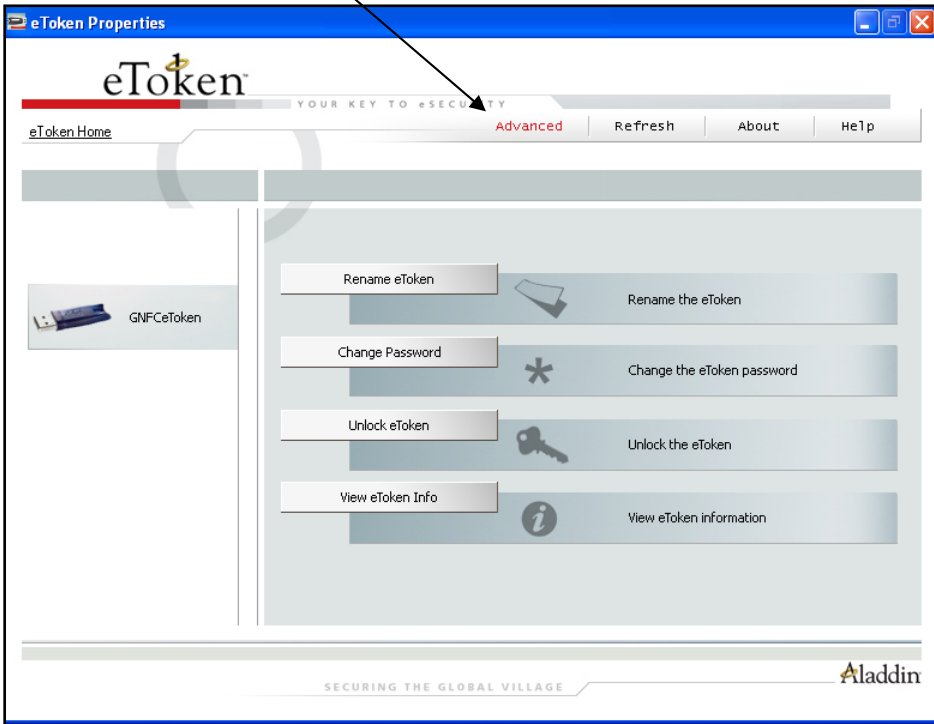
**STEP 4:** After giving eToken password and clicking OK, wait for 1-2 minutes till the Digital Certificates gets download – following message will appear.

Once the certificate is downloaded successfully Right click on the **eToken Properties** button in Taskbar and select “Open eToken Properties” or Click on Start > Programs > eToken > eToken Properties

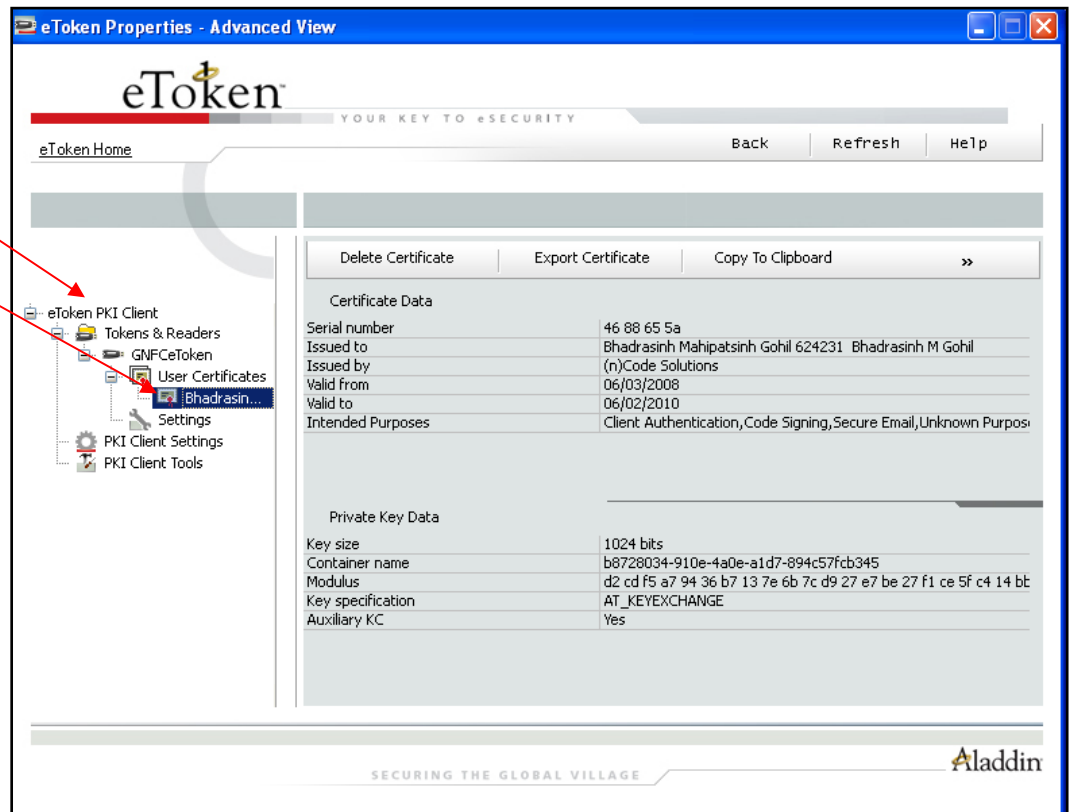


**To view your Digital Certificate in eToken and import CA-CCA Root Certificate follow steps as under:**

**STEP 5:** Click on "Advanced" button in eToken Properties

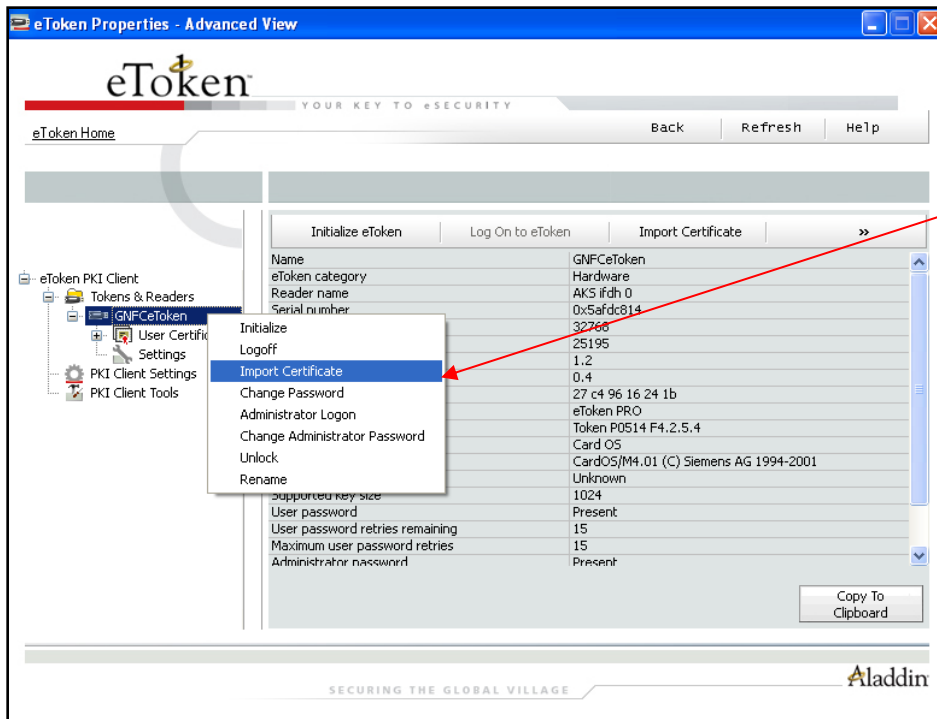


**Double Click on

to view your certificate**



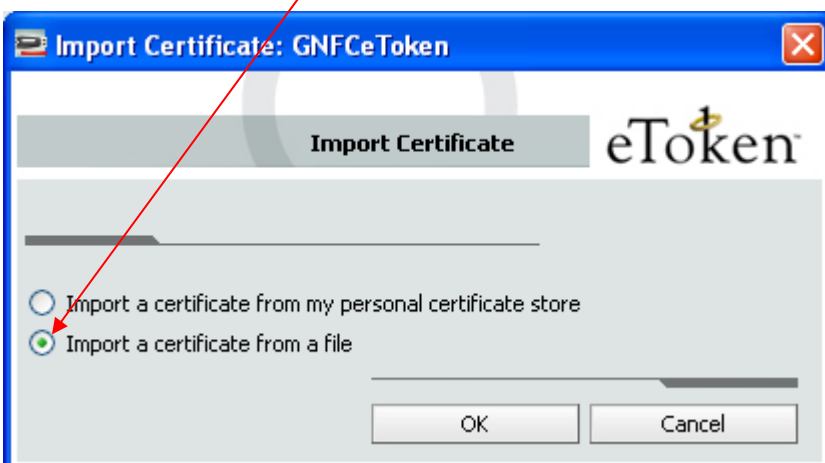
**STEP 5:** To import CA-CCA Certificate, first copy the same from the Resource CD as under:

1. Open "My Computer" > Right Click on CD Rom > Click Explore
2. Open "Code" folder > "Repository" folder >
3. Copy two files "(n)Code Solutions.cer" and "CCA India 2007.cer" and paste it on the Desktop

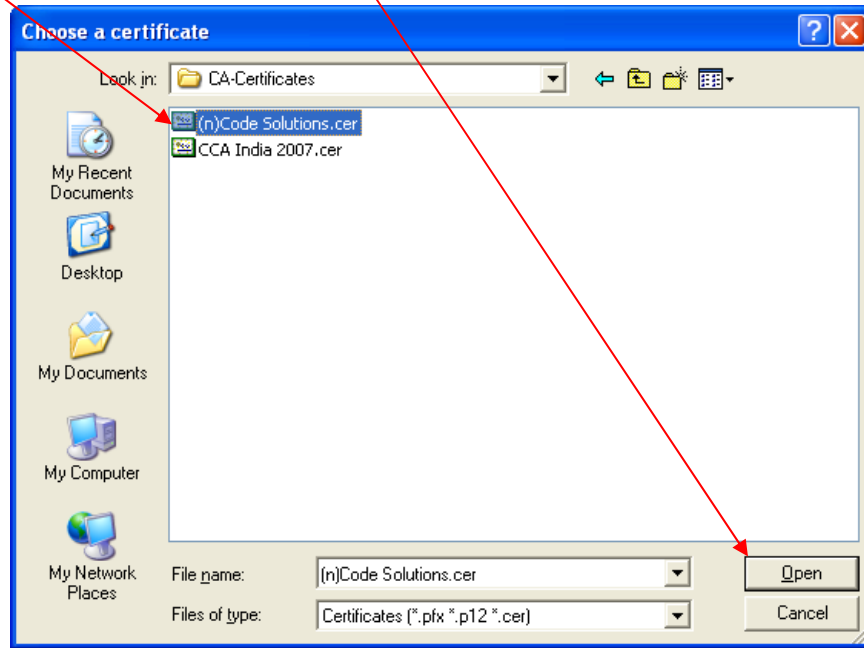


Right Click on "GNFC eToken" and select "Import Certificate"

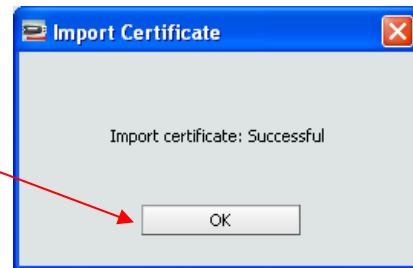
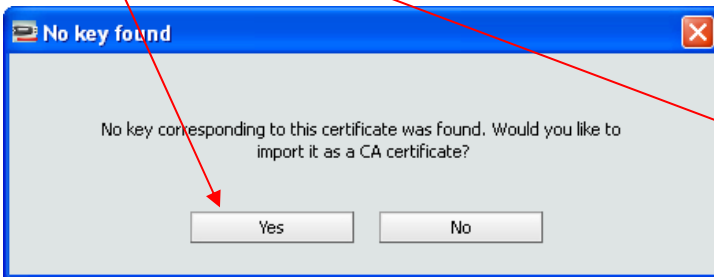
Select Import Certificate from file and click ok:



Choose (n)Code Solutions.cer and click Open

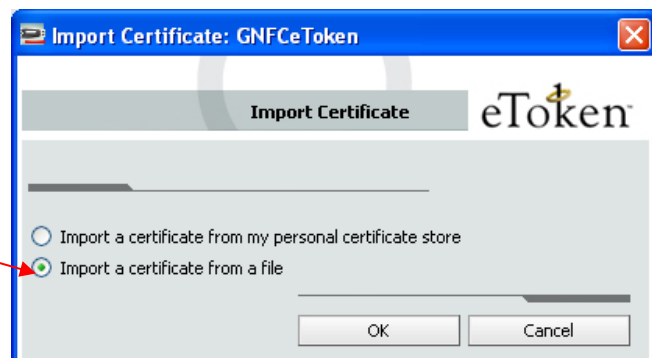


Click YES and OK on following prompts

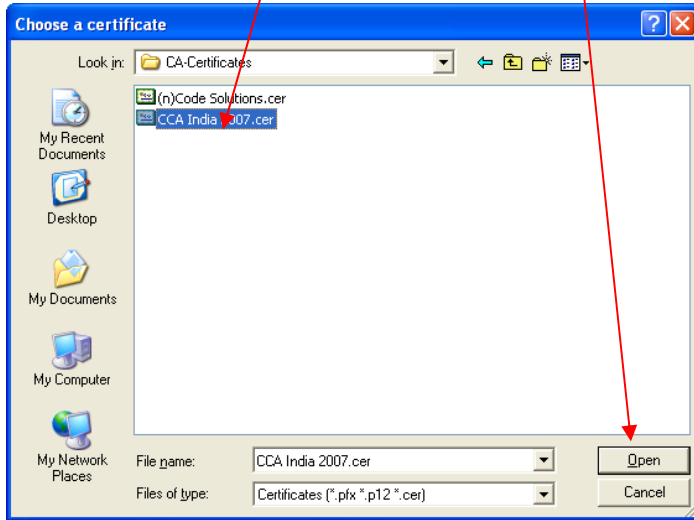


Now again Right Click on "GNFC eToken" and select "Import Certificate"

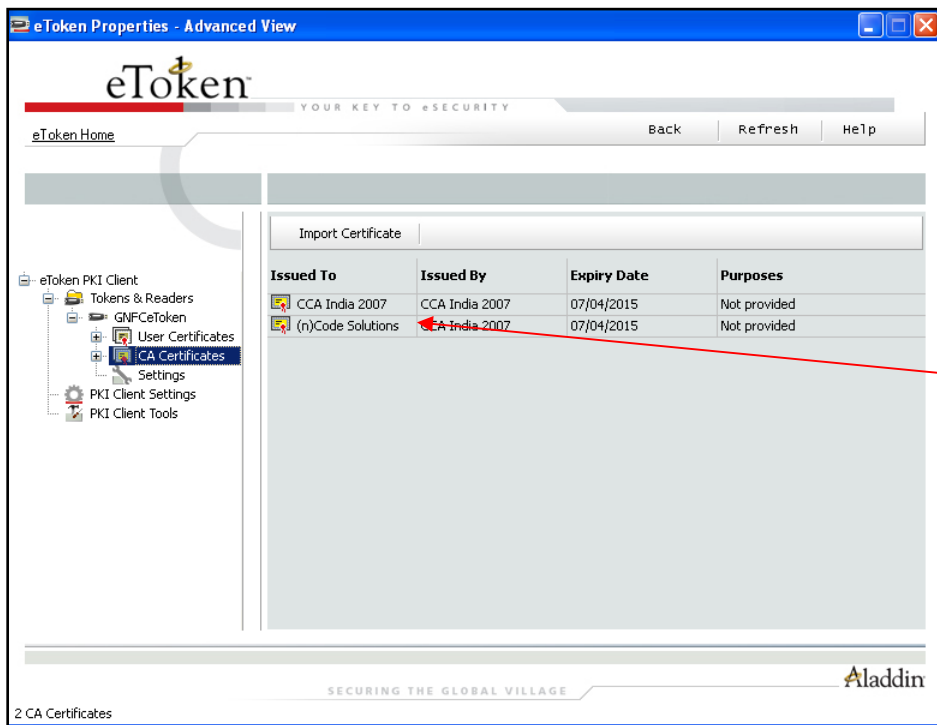
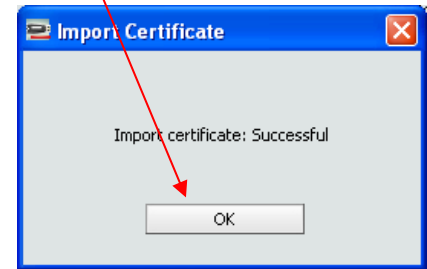
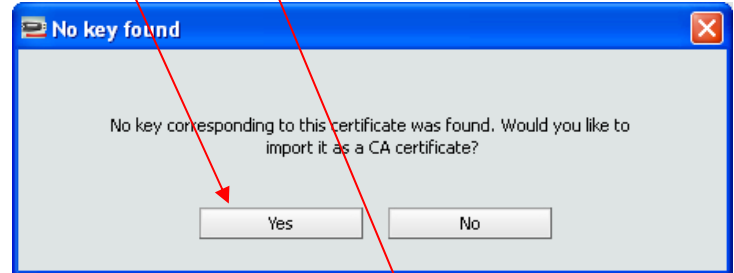
Select Import Certificate from file and click ok:

Both (n)Code and CCA Certificates will reflect

For viewing your Digital Signature Certificate in the eToken:

- ❖ Click Start > Programs > eToken > eToken Properties. Click "Advanced" and double-click on "GNFC eToken" – under that you will see User Certificates & CA Certificates
- ❖ Under User certificates option one can view certificate details viz. Issued To, Issued By, Validity, Serial Number etc.
